• Vorvergangenheit

② Had you written an email?

③ No, I hadn't written an email.

2. Verbform
She called her friend.

• normale Vergangenheit

② Did you call your friend?

③ No, I didn't call my friend.

Past Progressive
was/were + ing-Form
She was calling her friend.

• andauernde Vergangenheit

② Was she calling a friend?

③ No, she wasn't calling a friend.

Present Perfect
has/have + 3. Verbform
You have cleaned the bath.

• Vergangenheit bis Gegenwart
• ist gerade eben passiert
• ist wichtig für Gegenwart

② Have you cleaned the bath?

③ No, I haven't cleaned the bath.

1. Verbform
I play the piano.
⚠ he, she, it - S
She plays the piano.

• Gewohnheiten + Fakten

② Do you play the piano?

③ No, I don't play the piano.

Present Progressive
Form von to be + ing-Form
You are playing the piano.

• es passiert gerade jetzt

② Are you playing the piano?

③ No, I am not playing the piano.

Will Future
will + 1. Verbform
I will go to Rome.

going to
Future

Form von to be +
going to + 1. Verbform

• normale Zukunft

• passiert ganz sicher in der Zukunft

② Are you going to go to Rome?

③ No, I am not going to go to Rome.

② Will you go to Rome?
③ No, I won't go to Rome.

PRESENT

Simple Present

1. Verbform

I play the piano.

⚠ he, she, it - S

She plays the piano.

• Gewohnheiten + Fakten

(?) Do you play the piano?

(☹) No, I don't play the piano.

Present Progressive

Form von to be + ing-Form
You are playing the piano.

• es passiert gerade jetzt

(?) Are you playing the piano?

(☹) No, I am not playing the piano.

PAST

Simple Past

2. Verbform

She called her friend.

• normale Vergangenheit

❓ Did you call your friend?

☹ No, I didn't call my friend.

Past Progressive

was/were + ing-Form

She was calling her friend.

• andauernde Vergangenheit

❓ Was she calling a friend?

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FUTURE

will Future

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I will go to Rome.

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• passiert ganz sicher in der Zukunft

② Are you going to go to Rome?

③ No, I am not going to go to Rome.

② Will you

go to Rome?

③ No, I won't

go to Rome.
